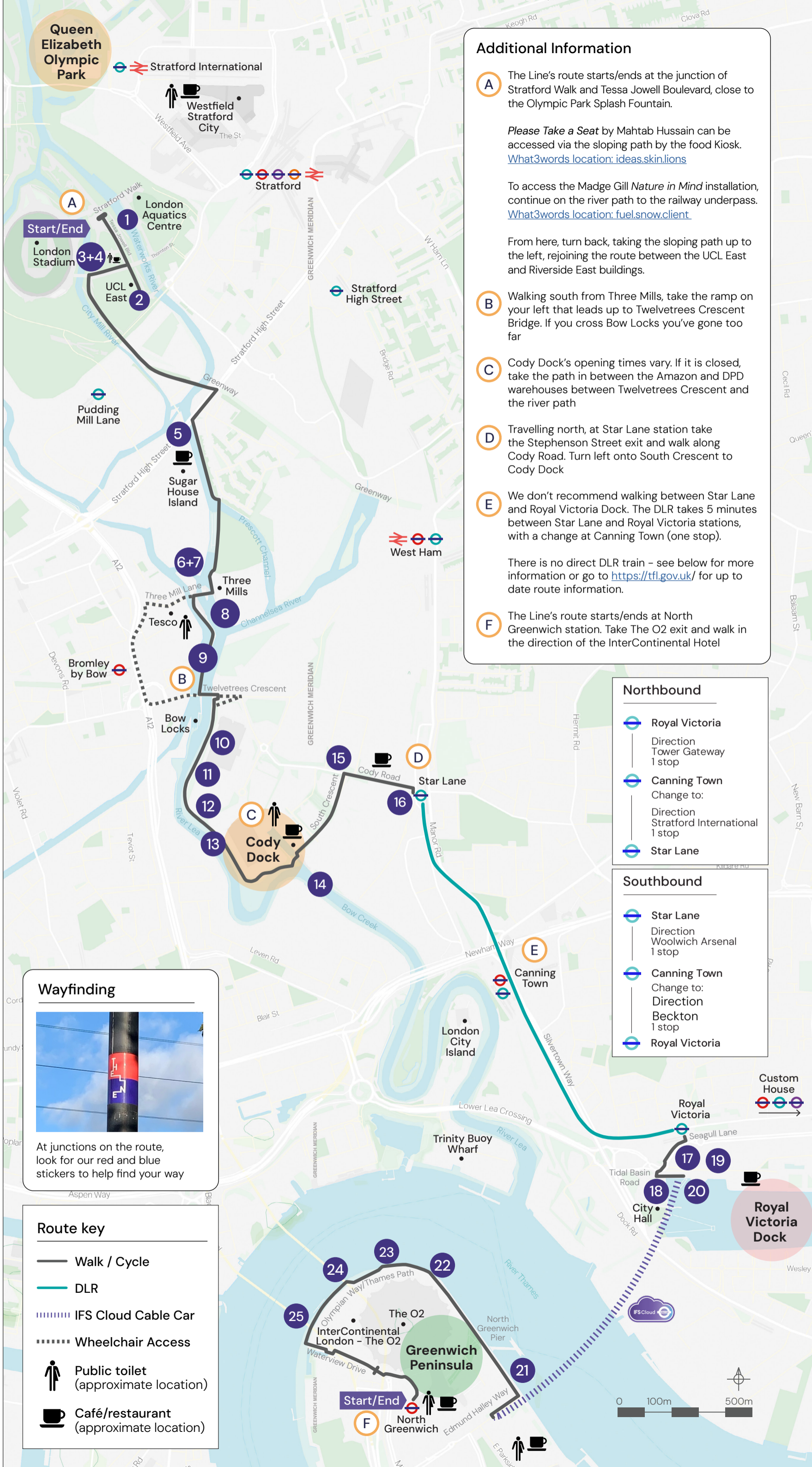
Wayfinding

Additional Information

- A** The Line's route starts/ends at the junction of Stratford Walk and Tessa Jowell Boulevard, close to the Olympic Park Splash Fountain.

To access the Madge Gill *Nature in Mind* installation, continue on the river path to the railway underpass.

From here, turn back, taking the sloping path up to the left, rejoining the route between the UCL East and Riverside East buildings.
- B** Walking south from Three Mills, take the ramp on your left that leads up to Twelvetrees Crescent Bridge. If you cross Bow Locks you've gone too far
- C** Cody Dock's opening times vary. If it is closed, take the path in between the Amazon and DPD warehouses between Twelvetrees Crescent and the river path
- D** Travelling north, at Star Lane station take the Stephenson Street exit and walk along Cody Road. Turn left onto South Crescent to Cody Dock
- E** We don't recommend walking between Star Lane and Royal Victoria Dock. The DLR takes 5 minutes between Star Lane and Royal Victoria stations, with a change at Canning Town (one stop).

There is no direct DLR train - see below for more information or go to <https://tfl.gov.uk/> for up to date route information.
- F** The Line's route starts/ends at North Greenwich station. Take The O2 exit and walk in the direction of the InterContinental Hotel
